### 1. The objects

The requested collection, described in the restitution request as “objects looted during the ‘Lombok Expedition’ (1894)” and known in the Netherlands as ‘Lombokschat’, includes of a range of items such as decorated metal objects, jewels, textiles, krisses and various decorative objects of gold and silver. The objects are registered in series RV-2364 and RV-4905, which together consist of 278 objects. Some additional objects, registered in other series, have also been linked to the Lombok war.

### 2. The policy framework

The assessment in this recommendation has been made within the framework of the *Policy Vision on Collections in a Colonial Context* of the Minister of Education, Culture and Science.<sup>1</sup> The policy vision is based on the *Colonial Collection and a Recognition of Injustice* report by the Council for Culture.<sup>2</sup> A restitution request may be submitted by a State where the Netherlands exercised colonial power for an extended period of time.

The assessment parameters are summarized in the Policy Vision as follows:

The Committee first establishes whether the provenance research is sufficient.

The Committee then establishes whether an involuntary loss of possession has occurred. This entails an assessment of whether it can be established to a reasonable degree of certainty that the requested cultural object was involuntarily lost in a country where the Netherlands exercised colonial authority for an extended period of time. If it is established that this is the case, an unconditional return of the cultural object will be recommended.

If it cannot be established on the basis of the provenance that there has been an involuntary loss of possession, and the cultural objects are of a particular cultural, historical or religious significance to the country of origin, the Committee will make a considered judgement, based on the various interests involved. The importance of restitution to the country of origin should be weighed in reasonableness and fairness against other relevant interests.

Relevant interests may include the cultural significance of the cultural object to the country of origin, the communities concerned in the countries of origin and in the Netherlands, the significance for the Collection Nederland, the future conditions in which the items would be kept, and public accessibility. Items can be of great importance to national and regional traditions and the identity of a country, people, community, or individual. The importance of a cultural object will often be different to the Netherlands than to the country of origin. For Dutch persons with roots in the countries of origin too, cultural objects in Dutch museums may have a special meaning.

If the requested item originates from a former colony of another power, the Committee also makes a considered judgment. The importance of restitution to the country of origin should be weighed in reasonableness and fairness against other relevant interests. However, the rectification of injustice will have to be the starting point in the assessment. In this case, the injustice has not been caused by the Netherlands, but the Netherlands, as the current owner of the items, is the only party capable of rectifying this injustice.

If the Committee recommends that an item or items be returned to the State requesting them, account should be taken – in accordance with the Heritage Act and the *Policy Vision on Collections in a Colonial Context* of the State Secretary for Culture and Media – of the public collections disposal procedure; the recommendation by the Committee should also be regarded as a recommendation on the indispensability and irreplaceability of the item as meant in Section 4.18 of the Heritage Act.

### 3. The procedure

On 1 July 2022, Indonesia submitted a request to the State Secretary for Culture and Media for the restitution of the ‘Lombokschat’ that had not previously been returned. The State Secretary asked the Colonial Collections Committee (hereinafter, ‘the Committee’) to advise on the request.

The custodian of the objects, the National Museum of World Cultures (hereinafter, ‘the NMVW’), has carried out a provenance investigation, and issued a report on the matter for the Committee, dated 7 November 2022. The Committee discussed the restitution request and the provenance report at its meeting of 21 December 2022. The Committee asked several additional questions in order to clarify the number of objects in the various categories referred to in the report, to which it received answers.

On 10 February 2023, the Committee spoke with Professor Wayne Modest, Director of Content, as a representative of the NMVW, the custodian of the collection. The custodian stated his support for restitution and his belief in the importance of working in partnership with the country from which the items originated.

On 30 January 2023, the Committee informed Dr Hilmar Farid, General Director of Cultural Affairs in Indonesia, and Mr Bonnie Triyana, the secretary of the Indonesian Repatriation Committee (hereinafter, ‘the Repatriation Committee’) about the progress of the procedure.

On 6 March 2023, the Committee spoke with Dr I Gusti Agung Wesaka Puja, the chair, a number of members, and the secretary to the Repatriation Committee. An English translation of the provenance investigation was shared with the Repatriation Committee. During the meeting, the subject was raised of whether there were any further questions about the request. This was not the case. The provenance investigation therefore gave no rise to any additional questions from the Repatriation Committee.

On 10 March 2023, the Committee discussed the restitution request again and decided to make recommendations as shown below.

#### 4. The provenance research

The provenance investigation was carried out by Mr T. Quist MA, who works as a provenance researcher at the National Museum of World Cultures. The report of the provenance investigation is appended to these recommendations (*Appendix 1*).

The contents of the report are regarded as part of this recommendation.

In a summarized form, the researcher set out the following findings in the report.

The collection of the National Ethnography Museum, part of the NMVW, still includes 278 of the more than five hundred objects that were looted in 1894 during the Lombok war by the Royal Netherlands East Indies Army (KNIL) and subsequently handed over by the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam to the National Ethnology Museum. The remainder were returned to Indonesia in 1977. 27 objects that also formed part of the property looted by the KNIL and which were transferred to the National Ethnology Museum are now missing. Additional investigations into the collections of the NMVW and the Wereldmuseum have revealed that a further 59 objects were certainly, or almost certainly, looted during the Lombok war, because they originate directly or indirectly from individual KNIL soldiers, navy personnel, or government officials who were stationed on Lombok during the war. Another 95 objects have been identified that could be related to the conflict.

#### 5. Assessing the restitution request

The restitution request was submitted by a State where the Netherlands exercised colonial power for an extended period of time, and therefore the *Policy Vision on Collections in a Colonial Context* is applicable.

The Committee is of the opinion that the investigation was conducted properly and provides a sufficiently solid basis on which to make a recommendation. A thorough source investigation has been carried out and existing knowledge has been critically evaluated. The report provides sufficient information about the origins of the objects, their removal, and their transport to the Netherlands.

The Committee subsequently examined whether this involved an involuntary loss of possession as meant in the policy framework. In doing so, the Committee considered the following.

It is important to establish who the owner of the objects was and whether permission was granted for the taking or the removal of them.

In 1894, Lombok was attacked and taken over by the Dutch colonial authorities. This involved violent military clashes between the KNIL and the Mataram-Cakranegara principality. In the Cakranegara Palace and on the battlefield, the KNIL looted 230 kilos of gold, 7,000 kilos of silver, and large quantities of jewellery and precious stones. These items are described in the Netherlands as 'Lombokschat' ('Lombok treasure'). After being shipped to the Netherlands, more than 500 of the objects were housed in the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam. This group of objects was later transferred by the Rijksmuseum to the National Ethnology Museum, now part of the NMVW. Part of this collection – 235 objects – were returned to Indonesia in 1977. A further 27 objects are missing. The remaining objects, which are still located at the NMVW, are 278 in number. These 278 objects are registered in series RV-2364 and RV-4905 (Appendix A to the provenance report). The Committee is of the opinion that it has been demonstrated with certainty that these objects were lost involuntarily.

As well as the 278 objects that were looted during the Lombok war, series RV-2364 and RV-4905 include several objects which, although they may have originated in Lombok, were part of Dutch collections during periods prior to the war. This concerns 25 objects (Appendix B to the provenance report). The documents relating to the objects contain no indication of how they ended up in Dutch collections. What is clear, however, is that these 25 objects were not looted during the capture of Lombok in 1894, given that they arrived in the Netherlands before that year. They do not therefore form part of the objects whose restitution is requested that were looted during the Lombok expedition of 1894. The question of whether restitution of these 25 objects should be considered is therefore currently not on the agenda.

Apart from the 278 objects in series RV-2364 and RV-4905, the NMVW has identified another 59 objects (of which 57 are in its own collection and two are in the collection of the Wereldmuseum and owned by the Rotterdam City Council) that were certainly, or almost certainly, looted during the Lombok war, because they originate directly or indirectly from individual KNIL soldiers, navy personnel, or government officials who were stationed on Lombok during the war (Appendix C to the provenance report). With regard to these 59 objects, the Committee has considered the following. This group was identified after a check on the documented details of every object in the NMVW collections whose cultural or geographical origin is registered as 'Lombok'. The identities of the donors, sellers, or other involved parties have been investigated in the National Archives records of KNIL soldiers, navy personnel, and government officials in the Dutch East Indies. In the case of some of these objects, there was a reference to the fact that they formed part of the items looted on Lombok. In other cases, it was possible to determine by other means that the donors had served in the KNIL or in the navy during the Lombok war. In the opinion of the Committee, it can therefore be established to a reasonable degree of certainty on the basis of the provenance report that these objects were looted during the war.

A further 95 objects have also been identified that may be linked to the Lombok war (four of which are in the collection of the Wereldmuseum and are the property of the Rotterdam City Council). This group of objects requires further investigation (Appendix D to the provenance report). It is quite possible that they were seized during the war, but concrete evidence for this is currently lacking. The provenance investigation has revealed possible options for further research: "These are objects which require further investigation, in view of their material properties, the time when they were acquired by the museums, the previous owners or a combination of these factors.. The Committee will therefore not yet make any recommendations about this latter group of objects, but await the outcome of any subsequent investigation.

On the basis of the aforementioned reasons, contained in the provenance report, it can be established to a reasonable degree of certainty that the following objects have been involuntarily lost: series RV-2364 and RV-4905 referred to in Appendix A to the provenance investigation and the 57 objects in the NMVW collection, referred to in Appendix C to the provenance investigation. The Committee therefore recommends that these objects be unconditionally returned on account of the involuntary loss of ownership.

The Committee has been asked to advise on the application of Section 4.18 of the Heritage Act if it recommends that the requested objects be returned. In the view of the Committee, the rectification of a past injustice prevails in this case and therefore Section 4.19 of the Heritage Act does not apply.

#### 6. The recommendation

The Committee has assessed the restitution request and recommends to the State Secretary that the following objects from the 'Lombokschat' be unconditionally returned to the Republic of Indonesia: series RV-2364 and RV-4905 referred to in Appendix A to the provenance investigation and the 57 objects in the NMVW collection, referred to in Appendix C to the provenance investigation.

This recommendation was adopted by the Colonial Collections Committee on 12 May 2023.

### Summary of research results

The collection of Museum Volkenkunde, part of the Nationaal Museum van Wereldculturen (National Museum of World Cultures, NMVW), still includes 278 of more than five hundred objects looted in 1894 by the Koninklijk Nederlandsch-Indisch Leger (Royal Netherlands East Indies Army, KNIL) during the Lombok War, and later transferred to Museum Volkenkunde from the Rijksmuseum Amsterdam. The other objects were returned to Indonesia in 1977. 27 objects also looted by the KNIL during the war have gone missing since they were transferred to Museum Volkenkunde. Additional research in the collections of NMVW and the Wereldmuseum has shown that a further 59 objects were definitely or in all likelihood looted during the Lombok war, as they came directly or indirectly from KNIL soldiers, navy personnel or administrators who were stationed in Lombok during the war. A further 95 objects that may be associated with the conflict were identified.

### Introduction

In 1894 the Dutch colonial administration in Batavia (Jakarta) took the island of Lombok by force. Thousands of men, women and children in Lombok lost their lives during the KNIL's military campaign against the principality of Mataram-Cakranegara. The KNIL looted 230 kilos of gold, 7000 kilos of silver and many items of jewellery and gemstones from the palace in Cakranegara and on the battlefield. Some of this 'Lombok treasure' was shipped to the Netherlands in 1896 and sold to cover the costs of the war and support the widows of KNIL soldiers who had been killed.<sup>1</sup>

The many remaining items were initially added to the collection of the Rijksmuseum Amsterdam, but were later given to Museum Volkenkunde. The first items arrived in 1937, and were registered in the collection under the serial number 2364; the other items followed in 1977, in series 4905. Shortly afterwards, almost 250 objects from these series were transferred to Indonesia as part of an agreement between the Dutch and Indonesian governments concerning the restitution of Indonesian collections at Dutch museums. More than three hundred items remained at Museum Volkenkunde after the restitution in 1977.<sup>2</sup>

In July and August 2022 the current status of the objects in series RV-2364 and RV-4905 was established using data in the NMVW's collection management system (The Museum System, TMS). This process covered missing objects, objects on loan and the presence of objects that were not looted during the Lombok War. The possible presence in the Indonesian collections of the NMVW and the Wereldmuseum of more looted items from Lombok, in addition to those in series RV-2364 and RV-4905, was also investigated. All objects found to be not missing and not restituted discussed in the

report are listed in appendices A–D, with some basic information and a photograph (if available).

### War loot in series RV-2364 and RV-4905

The number of objects missing from series RV-2364 and RV-4905 is 27; the number of objects present is 303. The absence of most of the missing objects was identified during the implementation of the Deltaplan voor het Cultuurbehoud (a Dutch government subsidy scheme for the preservation of cultural heritage) in the 1990s, before the corporatization of Museum Volkenkunde. Four objects had been missing since the late 1940s.<sup>3</sup> There may also be some missing items in series RV-03, which consists of over 2200 objects found without numbers in the museum repositories during work on the Deltaplan. To confirm whether this is the case, additional research must be carried out, comparing surviving descriptions of missing objects with the material features of objects in series RV-03.

Of the items present in series RV-2364 and RV-4905 55 objects are on loan to the Rijksmuseum Amsterdam and Leiden University Libraries (UB Leiden). The majority of these objects have been on display at the Rijksmuseum since September 2018 and are due to return to Museum Volkenkunde in November 2022. Two palm-leaf manuscripts have been on loan to UB Leiden since 1965.<sup>4</sup>

25 objects in the series RV-2364 and RV-4905 were not looted during the Lombok War (see appendix B). These objects are from the Rijksmuseum's collection and were given to Museum Volkenkunde in 1937, together with the war loot. Most of them had previously been at the Koninklijk Kabinet van Zeldzaamheden (Royal Cabinet of Curiosities), which was closed in 1883, at which time a large proportion of its collection was given to the Nederlandsch Museum van Geschiedenis en Kunst; this institution was later incorporated into the Rijksmuseum Amsterdam, and 's Rijks Ethnographisch Museum, known today as Museum Volkenkunde.<sup>5</sup> Documentation drawn up at the time of the transfer in 1937 clearly notes which objects were part of the 'Lombok treasure', and which were not.<sup>6</sup> On arrival, the 56 non-looted objects were registered as part of series 2364.<sup>7</sup> In 1971, 31 objects returned to the Rijksmuseum and 25 remained at Museum Volkenkunde, bringing the current number of war-looted items from Lombok in the series RV-2364 and RV-4905 to 278 (see appendix A). Of these, 22 are currently on display in Museum Volkenkunde's Indonesia gallery, and three in the permanent exhibit *Our Colonial Inheritance* at the Tropenmuseum.

### Other war loot in the collections of NMVW and the Wereldmuseum

Other than in series RV-2364 and RV-4905, a further 59 objects have been identified which were certainly or likely looted during the Lombok War (see appendix C). This selection was made on the basis of data and documentation in TMS concerning over 2700 tangible items in the collections of NMVW and the Wereldmuseum with cultural or geographical origins in Lombok. The names of any donors, sellers and other individuals involved were then checked in digital indexes to identify whether they appear in the service records of KNIL soldiers, navy personnel or administrators in the Dutch East Indies available on the website of the National Archives of the Netherlands.<sup>9</sup> The 59 objects in question are reported on the paper record cards for individual objects – part of the collection register prior to the introduction of TMS, which were subsequently digitalised – as being war loot from Lombok. Where this was not the case, it was possible to confirm using additional data in TMS and information from service records that the donors had served in the KNIL or the navy at the time of the Lombok War.<sup>10</sup> A large majority of the 59 objects came directly or indirectly from individual KNIL soldiers, navy personnel or administrators. Of the 47 objects in the collection of the Tropenmuseum, 32 were acquired through army doctor Herman Koppeschaar (1866- 1932).<sup>11</sup> The collections of Museum Volkenkunde and the Wereldmuseum include 10 and 2 objects respectively, though one palm-leaf manuscript has been on loan to UB Leiden since 1965.<sup>12</sup>

A further 95 objects were identified that may have been looted during the Lombok War, though no concrete evidence to confirm this has been found to date (see appendix D). These are objects which require further investigation, in view of their material properties, the time when they were acquired by the museums, the previous owners or a combination of these factors. The selection includes, for example, several krisses and other weapons from Lombok which were bought by 's Rijks Ethnographisch Museum at auction houses and from art dealers in the 1890s and the first decade of the 20th century. Objects acquired from individuals with a military background and/or military connections in their network have also been included in this group.
